Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day is observed annually on December 7th to commemorate the surprise attack on Pearl Harbor by the Japanese military on December 7, 1941. This event marked the United States' entry into World War II.

The day is dedicated to honoring the lives lost and the sacrifices made during the attack. Commemorative ceremonies are held at the Pearl Harbor National Memorial in Hawaii, where visitors and veterans gather to pay their respects.

The Paris Peace Accords Also known as the Agreement on Ending the War and Restoring Peace in Vietnam, was signed on January 27, 1973 in Paris, France. The agreement was signed by the leaders of four delegations: the United States and the Republic of Vietnam, and the Democratic Republic of Vietnam and the Viet Cong/Provisional Revolutionary Government.

The accords included:

- A cease-fire
- The return of American prisoners of war
- The withdrawal of American forces from South Vietnam within 60 days

The accords did not end all hostilities in Vietnam, Laos, or Cambodia, and fighting resumed shortly after the last American troops left in March 1973. The anti-communist South Vietnamese government fell two years later.

The Paris Peace Accords were an important step toward a post-war settlement. In 1995, the United States and Vietnam normalized relations, and in 2013, they agreed on a comprehensive partnership. done their duty.
