- 7. Participation in the Oral History Project increases *long-term* member engagement, starting with a simple interview.
- 8. We can reach out to recently lapsed members for renewal and project participation at no cost; you will receive **100%** of the membership dues we collect.
- 9. We can ask for donations on your behalf at no cost; you will receive **100%** of the donation money we collect.
- 10. At the conclusion of the project, you will have **unlimited**, **24/7** access to the digital vault which stores the audio, transcript, story, and photo for each participant.
