### **Ways to Get Involved:**

- Coordinate with school librarians or teachers for read aloud days, book donations, or themed literacy events around patriotic holidays (e.g., Veterans Day, Constitution Day).
- Partner with Public Libraries for special “Patriotism Through Literacy” story hours, book displays, or craft and read sessions with red, white, and blue themes.
- Organize reading activities, book drives, or invite Auxiliary members to read to the kids and share their stories with different daycare centers, preschools, and/or home school associations.
- Host a monthly or quarterly “Read with a Vet” event where veterans read patriotic children’s books to visiting families or scout troops.

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
