

KNOW YOUR LEGISLATORS

The U.S. House of Representatives is a chamber of the bicameral U.S. Congress; it is the lower house, with the U.S. Senate being the upper house. Together, the House and Senate have the authority to pass or defeat federal legislation, known as bills.

The number of voting representatives in the House is 435, proportionally representing the population of 50 states.

The number of voting Senators is 100, 2 in each of the 50 states.

Florida has 28 Districts in the House of Representatives.

Each State has 2 Senators

FINDING YOUR LEGISLATORS

Go to the internet and type in the following address:

www.usa.gov/elected-officials

Once you find your representative and/or senator, write down the physical address of their district office in FL, the email address, telephone number of their district office and the Washington, D.C. office.

- Find out where they stand on Veteran issues.
- Write a letter as a constituent.
- Be passionate and professional
- Don't assume they know our issues they have so many.
- Make a friend of the staffers – often they decide what gets attention first.
