Deadlines – to the Auxiliary March 31; to the Department Chair April 15<sup>th</sup>. Entries are judged on patriotic theme and technique.

Special instructions for 3-Dimensional Patriotic Art Contest: Careful packaging is extremely important to protect the student's priceless artwork to avoid damage during shipping. There is a "new" requirement this year - a color photo must accompany the entry. If the artwork is damaged during shipping the judges can still see what the art was meant to look like.

Entry form is required and available in MALTA Member Resources. VFW Auxiliaries must send the required entry form to the Department Scholarships Chairman by March 31, 2026 for judging.

The Department Scholarships Chairman must sign and send a copy of the completed Department-winning entry form to the National Scholarships Ambassador by April 30, 2026 for judging.

Citations will be mailed directly to winning VFW Auxiliaries from National Headquarters and money will be deposited into the VFW Auxiliary account after the 2026 VFW Auxiliary National Convention.
