NVS has VFW Accredited Service Officers who are experts in navigating the VA processes, filing for disability compensation, rehabilitation and education programs, pension and death benefits. These services are provided to anyone seeking assistance and are **FREE of Charge**.

VFW's **Veterans & Military Support Program (VMS)** which includes

Financial Assistance for Service Members is here to help America's active-duty service members (to include activated Guard/Reserve members) and their families who have run into unexpected financial difficulties because of deployment or other military-related activity or injury. The program provides financial assistance up to \$2,500 to assist with daily necessities in the form of a grant – not a loan – so no repayment is required.



Military Appreciation Program (MAP)

offers grants to VFW Posts that participate in military unit functions, such as sponsoring farewell and welcome home activities.



Sport Clips Help a Hero Scholarship gives tuition assistance to eligible service members.
