The VFW National Home is currently in the process of renovating the Health & Education Building, with focus on the offices downstairs where the Veterans Resource Center opened in October, 2022. The Veterans Resource Center helps veterans and their families access resources and support they otherwise may not be able to find or afford. Note: When this Auxiliary-sponsored building opened nearly a century ago, it was the campus hospital. For a while, it even housed quarantined children with tuberculosis.

How Much? The National Home needs an estimated \$10,000 to complete this project. (Any excess will go toward additional Veterans Resource Center necessities.)

How Can We Help? There are nearly 3,500 Auxiliaries. If each Auxiliary were to donate \$3 in December, the National Home could finish 2022 having already met their goal! 

Don't forget New Year's eve drop off horn's, cards and cookies to a Veteran's home or nursing facility, So that they can ring in the New Year. The Cooties have a special moto "Keep them smiling in beds of white" Did you know that January 24th is Belly Laugh day what can you do to make a Veteran laugh or smile? Other holiday's coming up are Valentines Day, St. Patrick's Day, Easter, Mothers Day, Fathers day and Armed Forces Day.

Women Health Care set up a table outside local stores, farmers markets or local events to talk to female Veterans about women's benefits, Maternity care, Mental Health issues, Breast Cancer Cervical Cancer and Military Sexual Trauma and so much more. You can down load and print pamphlets from the VA website at:

www.womenshealth.va.gov. How and who they can talk to about filing a claim. Many men and women don't know that they can receive help and compensation for Military Sexual Trauma.

Honors Escort speak with local Hospitals, Nursing Homes about setting up an honors escort. Some hospitals will allow Veterans to even line the corridors for veterans who are dying and donating their organs to others. Speak with Nursing Homes and VA and Non-VA hospitals about setting up an Honors escort. Have a group set up to show the family's and other Veterans how much we respect the honor and duty they provided for our freedom.

Women Veterans Health Care

In September 1923, the predecessors to the VA approved first spaces for women health care. The VA has come a long way since then. The VFW and the Auxiliaries have been working to enhance women's health care since 2013, when women were first allowed to join combat at the front lines. Here are a few Ideas to enhance a veterans day or stay in the VA or Non-VA facility.



Try a drive through baby shower give away diapers, wipes, baby food, or team up with other organizations to provide cribs or highchairs.



Provide toiletry bags for female Veterans with tampons, pads, shampoo, conditioner and lotion.



PJ or Nightgowns to replace the old worn out gowns given at most facilities. Fresh clean new underwear also make a women feel good during the stay.



Set up a table outside or inside if the facility will let you to talk about benefits women veterans can receive.



Non VA Facilities make Fidget Blankets, quilts or pillows to help with dementia patents.



Don't forget to get your reports in. Be interesting, add fluff, tell me about how you felt, how happy the Veterans were. Tell me about where, what and how you did and the planning that went into it. I want to here everything. I have really enjoyed the reports that I have read so far.
