Recruitment of Volunteers

- At each post have a sign-up small notebook for people to put in name and hours they have volunteered for any program
- Quarterly luncheon recognition and event planning to recognize those who have volunteered and share ideas (Sponsorships to cater the luncheon

- Visit Nursing/Assisted living handing out cards with kisses (Hersey's)
- Auxiliary host a Valentines Day Dinner/Dance set table with Roses & Candy hearts

Honors Escort Honors Escort – This program can be provided in hospital, Nursing Home, Hospice as a special ceremonial procession to honor Veterans after their death.

 - Special Award to one Auxiliary that hosts an activity and/or event that recognizes veterans on non-traditional holidays. Entry form required and available in MALTA Member Resources. Auxiliaries must send the entry form to their Department Hospital Chairman by March 31, 2024, for judging.
- 2. Special Award to one Auxiliary with the most outstanding initiation of an Honor Escort Program, in a hospital or nursing home. Judging based on number of auxiliary members and description of program established.
- 3. Special Award to one Auxiliary for the most creative valentines to Veterans in a nursing home/assisted living. Judging based on number of auxiliary/post members involvement, special event and valentines distributed.
- 4. Special Award to one Auxiliary that hosts the most outstanding Educational Seminar for education on women veteran programs by hosting an event at your post and using information from MALTA Member Resources under the Hospital Program.

Entry form required and available in MALTA Member Resources. Plaque to be mailed directly to the winner after the National Convention.
- 3. Citation to the Outstanding Hospital Volunteer of the Year in each of the 10 Program Divisions. Entry form required and available in MALTA Member Resources. Citations will be mailed directly to the winners after the National Convention.

AWARDS FOR AUXILIARIES

- 1. Most outstanding activity and/or event that recognizes veterans on non-traditional holidays.
 - Citation to every Auxiliary that hosts activity and/or event that recognizes veterans on nontraditional holidays. Entry form required and available in MALTA Member Resources. Auxiliaries must send the entry form to their Department Hospital Chairman by March 31, 2024, for judging. Citations will be mailed directly to participating Auxiliaries from National Headquarters.
 - Citation and \$25 to one Auxiliary in each of the four Conferences that hosts the most outstanding activity and/or event recognizing veterans on non-traditional holidays. Citations will be mailed directly to winning Auxiliaries from National Headquarters and money will be deposited into Auxiliary account after National Convention.
