This year we will be seeking to find Mentees within our organization and develop their skills at all levels. An Auxiliary member once told me to *"latch onto someone who has walked were you want to go"*. In other words, if I wanted to become a District President, I should seek someone who has been a District President to be my mentor. Mentoring is our only program that exclusively benefits our members and you don't have to fund raise for the program.

One of the main techniques we will implement is the Care Concept!

- **C**atch the member when they first join Do you remember your first meeting? Was it scary or did you feel welcome?
- Ask them to participate
- Remember what it felt like to be new
- Engage them in a program that fits them or their talents.

We will be incorporating a new component into the Auxiliary and District levels -Best Buddies!

Every Auxiliary, and District needs to have a Best Buddy Coach.

This person will greet all new members when they join the Auxiliary and sit with them at their first several meetings.

Your Best Buddy Coach cannot be an officer that has special seating such as the Sr. Vice for instance. They must be friendly and approachable. They will provide all the "*New Member Materials*". We will help establish these materials if your Auxiliary does not have them yet.

This person can also be your Mentor Coach and help acclimate new members to our organization.

Each Auxiliary shall have a Mentor Coach to help teach new members and future leaders! *(Please come to Boot Camp in August for Tons more info)*

Every Auxiliary should hold a training event to help mentors find their perspective Mentees and help them grow in areas of their interest. You can hold them locally with several Auxiliaries working together or even as a District function. District training sessions are highly encouraged. Our organization only grows when our membership is encouraged to participate and share their talents! Incorporating games into the event will help to keep the members involved while they learn. Please remember **EVERY MEMBER** has a worthy Talent, or passion that we need to discover
