 - Send reminders most teachers can be emailed.
 - Be sure to celebrate the winners.
- WINTER: Continuing Education Submit to National Headquarters by 2/15/23

 Open to all Auxiliary members (must be a member for at least one year), their spouses or their children age 18 or older and is need based. A 300-word essay is required.
- SPRING: Young American Patriotic Art Contest and new this year Young American 3- Dimensional Patriotic Art Contest entries to Post by 3/31/23

 These two art scholarships have specific criteria as to medium, size, etc. Get the word out in January so teachers and students will have time to create their artwork.
 - Visit the school, talk to the students. Invite them to your post for an "Ice Cream and Paint Night" to work on their projects. Show them examples of past entries and winners. These scholarships are funded based on our contributions so please plan to do set aside some funds from an event to contribute to **Fund the Artist of Tomorrow**.
