  - VFW's National Veterans Service (NVS) consists of a nationwide network of VFW Accredited Service Officers who are experts in dealing with the VA. They help veterans, service members and their families obtain the benefits they deserve. Benefits include disability compensation (pension & death benefits), medical rehabilitation, educational, employment and training programs. There is no cost for this to the veteran, also the veteran does not have to be a member of the VFW.
  - VFW Veterans & Military Support Programs serve active-duty and recently discharged members of the military.
    - Unmet Needs is there to help America's military families who have run into unexpected financial difficulties because of deployment or other military-related activity or injury.
    - ✓ VFW's "Sport Clips Help A Hero Scholarship" provides service members and veterans with scholarships of up to \$5,000 to complete their educational goals without incurring excessive student load debt.
    - ✓ **The Military Assistance Program (MAP** Grants) help to provide financial assistance to VFW Post and Auxiliaries to sponsor troop send-offs, homecomings, and get-togethers. Posts and Auxiliaries participating in Adopt-A-Unit and Family Readiness Groups can also receive assistance.
    - ✓ The Veterans Village in Ft. McCoy provides a true home-like atmosphere to veterans and their spouses. The Village needs our support to continue to provide a place for our veterans and their spouses in their retirement.

The Veterans and Family Support Program is our opportunity to provide aid and support to those who have given so much for us all, our veterans and their families.
